Art

The High School Art Department continues to reinforce a Discipline-Based Art Education program. It emphasizes a fine arts approach, beginning with a foundation course and moving on to more specialized offerings. Thus, students develop a common understanding of vocabulary, materials, methods, and the importance of fine craftsmanship, quality design, and creative self-expression. They are exposed to a variety of interdisciplinary, multicultural, and cooperative learning experiences while strengthening art skills and exploring various processes. Students combine influences of past and present artists so as to aid the evolution of their own techniques and styles. Students learn to integrate art history, art criticism, and aesthetics, along with studying art's role in the surrounding visual world. This is achieved through multimedia presentations and lectures by guest artists. Students gain experience in displaying their artwork through exhibitions such as the John Slade Eli House showing, Art Beat, and Art Guild. Drawing and Painting, Crafts, Pottery and Sculpture, Photography and Independent Study are elective courses offered. The courses are designed to inspire awareness of cultural significance, historical backgrounds and contemporary trends that influence art. Students are provided opportunities to celebrate art for its daring and beauty, which has earned it a place among humanity's finest creative efforts.

The more the years moved forward the more we grew to see advisors do much more than guide: I'm sure you all agree.






